

The TJC Promise provides every eligible high school freshman within the TJC tax district the opportunity to earn up to two years of a college education at TJC. Beginning in 2020, qualifying graduates from Tyler, Chapel Hill, Grand Saline, Lindale, Van and Winona ISD's can receive up to two years of tuition and fees.

The Promise program starts during the second semester of a student's freshman year in high school. The student will sign a pledge and promise to meet established requirements based on academic achievement, persistence and community service. A parent/guardian will also sign the pledge to provide an environment that will promote and encourage the student to achieve the requirements during high school.

If a student attends at least two full years at a high school within the TJC tax district and meets the requirements, he or she will earn a TJC Promise Scholarship.



## **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT**

### **GRADE POINT AVERAGE (WEIGHTED)**

Complete each year in high school with a cumulative GPA equal to or greater than a 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or an 80 on a 100-point scale

### **COLLEGE READY**

Graduate high school college-ready as defined by the state of Texas



## **PERSISTENCE**

### **ABSENCES (UNEXCUSED)**

Five (5) days or fewer during the second semester of freshman year

Ten (10) days or fewer during each year, sophomore through senior

No more than two (2) mandatory disciplinary actions as defined in the Texas Education Code

### **PROGRESS**

Advance each year with their class

### **COLLEGE**

Come directly to TJC after graduating from high school



## **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

Five (5) service hours or more during the second semester of freshman year

Ten (10) service hours or more during each year, sophomore through senior
